Many names are dear, but the dearest one that grows dear with the passage of time is the simple, yet sublime name, JESUS. It is the name the angel announced before Christ was born, and represented Him as a gift from heaven who, in His person, would fulfill the promise of Jehovah to save His people. In Matthew it says, the one born into the world. The coming of the Eternal Son was a manifestation of God's love towards a sinning world. The banner is made of purple velvet, gold lame' and white fabric trimmed in red.

Purple: Signifies the deity of God, the color of kings associated with royalty and majesty.

Gold: Indicates brilliance and purity, symbolic of righteousness.

White: Signifies Holiness, and purity and light which is white. "Jesus is the Light of the World!"

Red: Signifies the blood that was shed for our sins.

The Crown worn by Kings--Jesus is the King of Kings and Lord of Lords.

The back of the banner -- Circle & Triangle -- Jesus said, "I am the Alpha and Omega, the Beginning and the End -- the Trinity - three in One and Eternal Life."
