

KING OF KINGS

This was a title well known in the east, indicating one of supreme power. A ruler bearing this title has many kings subject to him. Applied to Jesus, the designation points to the time when "the kingdom of this world becomes the world-kingdom of our Lord, and He shall reign for ever and ever". Rev. 19:16 "And on His robe and on His thigh He had a name written, '**KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS**'." (NASB)

Red: The background is red which represents the blood of Christ for the atonement of our sins.

Gold: The trim, which is gold, is a symbol of righteousness, and also represents choice and fine treasure.

Bells: The bells signify holiness unto the Lord.

Crown: The crown around the cross reminds us of the King of all kings who gave His life on a cross so we may live an eternal life.
