

# JEHOVAH ROPHA

The name Jehovah Ropha means the Lord who Heals. Exodus 15:26 (NASB) "If you will give earnest heed to the voice of the Lord your God, and do what is right in His sight, and give ear to His commandments, and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you which I have put on the Egyptians; For I, the Lord am your healer." -- that is Jehovah Ropha. The word Heal (Hebrew word Ropha) appears 36 times in the Old Testament, always meaning to restore, to cure, not only in the physical sense but in the moral and spiritual sense also.

The hands touching are a reminder of God's healing hand touching ours. The burgundy or purple background refers to the colors of kings, associated with royalty. The brown used in the letters is a color associated with sorrow or disease. The silver is symbolic of God's Word; it signifies redemption; purification by affliction. The white is sign of triumph.

This banner is dedicated to the Lord as a reminder of the healing from cancer He has done in my personal life, "...for I am Jehovah that healeth thee."
