"Then Gideon built an alter to the Lord and named it Jehovah-Shalom, (the Lord is Peace)." Judges 6:24 (NASB)

Shalom, as used in the Old Testament has various meanings harmonizing with the doctrine of the atonement as the basis of peace with God. Peace is spoken everywhere in the New Testament. It may be only by reconciliation with God through the blood of Christ who is the Jehovah-Shalom. "Therefore having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ." Romans 5:1 (NASB)

Blue: The banner is blue, which is the color of Jehovah, the symbol of the revealed God.

White: Signifies holiness and purity, a symbol of glory and majesty.

Silver: The trim signifies redemption.

Dove: Has become a symbol of the Holy Spirit and only through the Holy Spirit can we realize true peace.
