

# LAMB OF GOD

This banner tells of the perfect Lamb of God sent down as sacrifice for the sins of man. He was slain on the cross to pay the price for sin and redeem all men. He rose again and is now at the right hand of God the Father as the crowned King of Glory.

**SACRIFICE:** 1 Peter 1:19 "but with precious blood, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, the blood of Christ." (NASB)

**REDEEMER:** Revelation 5:9 "And they sang a new song, saying, 'Worthy are You to take the book and to break its seals; for You were slain, and purchased for God with Your blood men from every tribe and tongue and people and nation.'" (NASB)

**KING:** Revelation 15:3 "And they sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, Great and marvelous are thy works, Lord God Almighty; just and true are thy ways, thou King of saints." (KJV)

The purple, green and gold in the background represent the royalty, fruitfulness, purity and righteousness of the Lamb. His crown shows the victory He won over Satan when He arose from the dead. Shades of purple in the border, backing and trims speak of His royalty.
